-Green Mountain Farm to School will be bringing their Lunch Box program to the library this summer.

-STEM camp is set for the April school break. Jerry Piette has created a curriculum and schedule for the 3 days of classes. A \$1000 grant has been awarded to help with extending hours at the library during the school break.

-Trisha has applied for \$800 in funding towards summer programming from the state. So far, \$300 of that request has been confirmed.

-Tanya Sousa (author from Troy) is working with Trisha to develop a creative writing workshop in the fall. Trisha is pursuing grant funding.

-The current Municipal Planning Grant will be ending at the end of May.

-University of Irasburg has 19 classes available to the public during the month of April, 3 of these are STEM classes for middle school children.

-The grass bank between the road and the sidewalk needs steps with a railing built into it. Patrons with mobility problems cannot step up and over the existing bank and are having to walk a long distance out of their way to enter the library.
