

## Minutes / Meeting of Leach Library Board of Trustees / November 10, 2020

The Board of Trustees of the Leach Public Library met outdoors, masked and distanced, on the bleachers of the baseball diamond on November 10, 2020. It was a beautiful day for an outdoor meeting, although the noise from the passing trucks occasionally forced a pause in the proceedings. Present were Phillis Mosher, Molly Veysey, Judith Jackson and Library Director Laurie Green-Holland. Absent were Gretchen Bittner and Robin Kay.

The meeting came to order at 10:45. The members approved the minutes of the previous meeting.

The Energize Vermont project to insulate the library attic and basement has now been completed. A new toilet seat has been installed in the rest room. Ms. Veysey reported that the recent grant application was not accepted. Members thanked Ms. Veysey for her valiant grant-writing effort.

Ms. Veysey reported on plans to continue with a curbside version of the enrichment program during the Thanksgiving holiday. Families can pick up enrichment kits at the library to take home.

The members discussed the feasibility of keeping the library in operation as the number of cases of COVID-19 rise in Vermont. The decision was to remain open for the time being and watch the local case rate. (Members decided on November 14, via email, to close the library to normal operations and to offer curbside service on Saturdays.)

Members approved the October expense/revenue report.

The date for the next meeting was set for Tuesday, December 8, 2020, with the meeting to be held remotely.
